Delegates analyze and pitch a buy or sell recommendation on a publicly traded equity to a panel of industry professionals.

Financial Crisis Case

Delegates are tested on their ability to make decisions on current market events and will be challenged to create innovative solutions to address changing market conditions.

Technical Case

Delegates present a recommendation after correcting errors in a valuation model to judges by leveraging their financial modelling and technical skills.
